

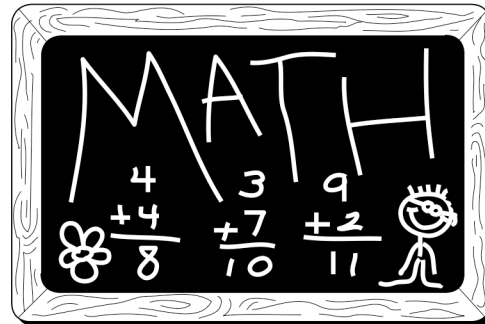

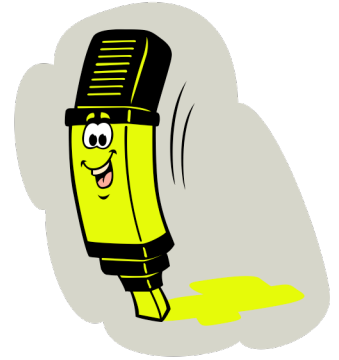


Study BUNCH Time to Review...
