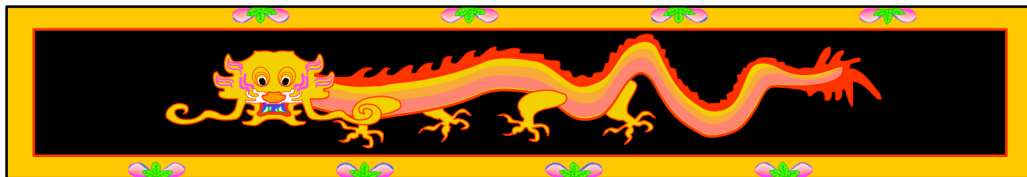
Mrs. Bunyi's Class
